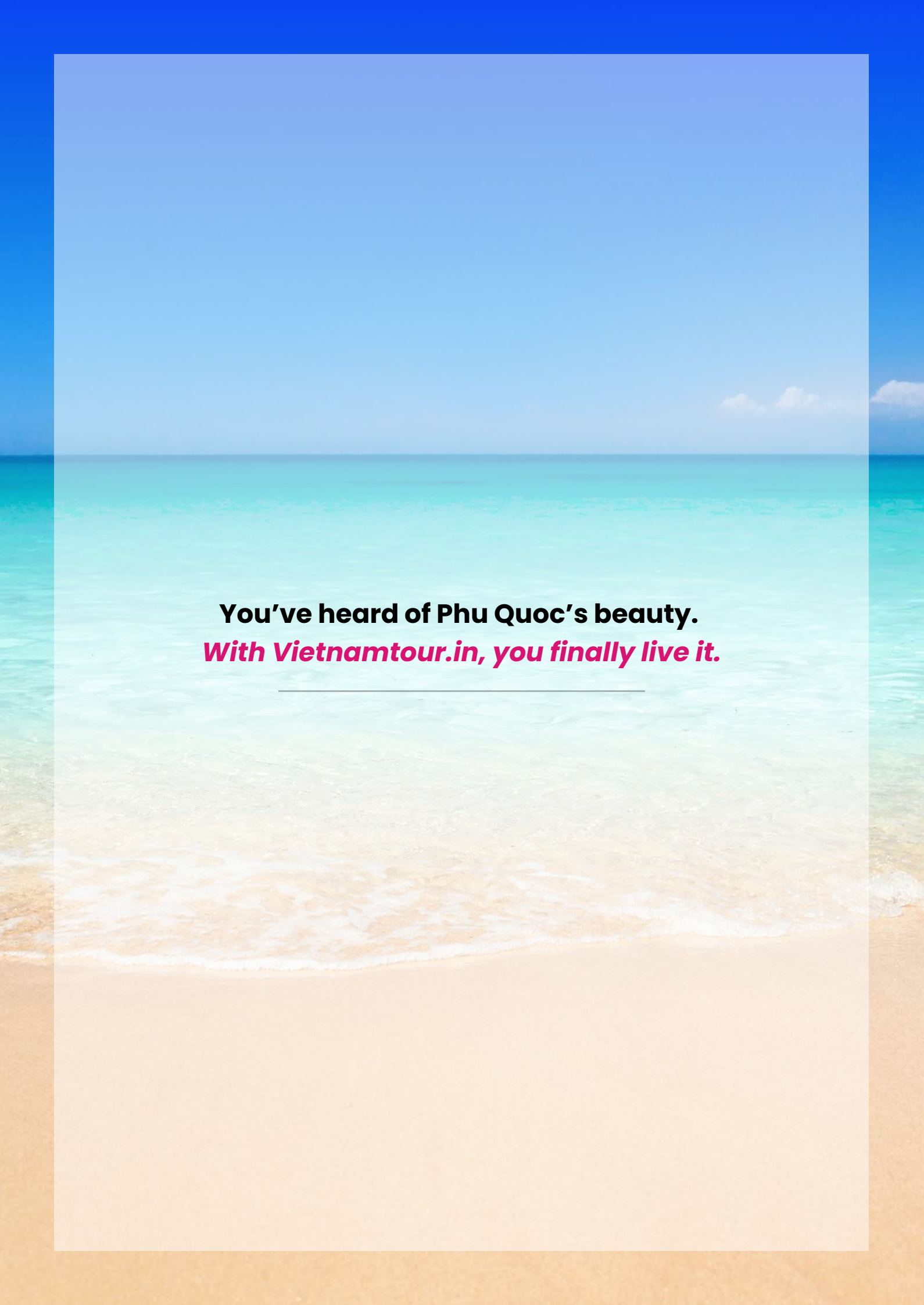

Phu Quoc isn't just about pretty beaches. It's a mix of nature, culture, food, fun, and a little bit of surprise. In this section, you'll find everything from quiet fishing villages to roller coasters, island-hopping tips to evening shows — all the things that make this island worth more than just a lazy holiday.



Phu Quoc is often called the “**Pearl Island**,” and it’s easy to see why when you visit its beaches. Each beach here offers something different, but all share the same peaceful, natural charm.

Nature & Beaches



With powdery white sand and calm turquoise water, **Sao Beach** has earned its place on the Top 50 Beaches in the World by FlightNetwork. This southern beach is a must-visit for those chasing postcard-perfect views.

SAO BEACH



Khem Beach has crystal-clear water and smooth, white sand, a lovely spot for a walk or a simple moment of quiet.

KHEM BEACH



Starfish Beach is known for the starfish you can see in shallow water. It’s a great place for a short snorkel or just to sit by the sea.

STARFISH BEACH

GANH DAU CAPE

Located at the island's northwestern tip, Ganh Dau offers sweeping coastal views and a glimpse of Cambodia on the horizon. The area remains quiet and untouched, ideal for a short escape.

ONG LANG BEACH

Ong Lang Beach offers golden sand and gentle waves, lined with trees and a few low-key resorts. It's a great option for couples or families looking to avoid the crowds without going too remote.

LONG BEACH (BAI TRUONG)

Stretching over 20 kilometers along the west coast, Long Beach is lined with beach bars, cafés, and sunset spots. Named by CNN Travel as one of the best sunset beaches in Vietnam, this is the island's most social shoreline.





SUOI TRANH, SUOI DA BAN

These streams and small waterfalls flow gently through forested areas, offering shade, cool water, and a picnic-friendly setting, especially during the rainy season.

Must-Visit Spots of Phu Quoc



Kiss Bridge

Set within Sunset Town, this pair of curved bridges stretches toward each other above the sea, symbolizing love and connection. Come at sunset — it might just be the perfect place to propose.



Sunset Town (An Thoi)

This mediterranean-inspired seaside town area has become one of Phu Quoc's most photographed spots with colorful buildings, sea-view cafés, and romantic walking paths.



Access to Hon Thom Cable Car

If you're in Sunset Town, don't miss the chance to ride the world's longest sea cable car — it's right next door.



Dinh Cau Temple

Small seaside temple with ocean views and sunset spot.



Ham Ninh Village

Rustic fishing village known for stilt houses and crab.



Ho Quoc Pagoda

Peaceful hilltop temple facing the sea, great for sunrise.



Sim Wine Houses

Learn how sim (rose myrtle) wine is made. Some spots offer tasting and a quick look into the local way of processing fruit.



Phu Quoc Prison

Historic wartime prison museum with preserved exhibits.



Fish Sauce Factory

See how Vietnam's iconic fish sauce is made traditionally.



Pepper Farms

Walk through lush plantations and taste fresh local pepper.



Pearl Farms

Learn how pearls are cultivated and browse jewelry shops.



VINWONDERS PHU QUOC

Vinwonders Phu Quoc is the island's biggest amusement park, great for families or anyone who enjoys a bit of fun.

There are exciting rides, themed zones, and activities for all ages, especially kids.

It's a good place to spend a full day if you're looking for something more energetic during your trip.

GRAND WORLD PHU QUOC

Grand World is like a little city inside Phu Quoc. You'll find colorful buildings, lively shops, night markets, and even parades or cultural shows. It's great for walking around, taking photos, and trying different foods, both Vietnamese and international.



VINPEARL SAFARI PHU QUOC

Vinpearl Safari is Vietnam's first semi-wildlife park.

Animals here live in open spaces, and you can even join a safari-style tour to see them up close.

You'll meet giraffes, rhinos, zebras, and more. It's both fun and educational, a nice day out for animal lovers.



AQUATOPIA WATER PARK (HON THOM)

Located on Hon Thom Island, **Aquatopia Water Park** is one of the most modern water parks in Southeast Asia. It offers over 20 state-of-the-art water slides, wave pools, and family-friendly zones surrounded by tropical scenery.



TEDDY BEAR MUSEUM

The **Teddy Bear Museum** in Phu Quoc is the first of its kind in Vietnam, where visitors can follow the adventures of Teddy Jones across themed rooms and interactive exhibits. It's a delightful stop for families, blending storytelling with adorable photo opportunities.



BAMBOO LEGEND PARK

Bamboo Legend Park is a cultural theme park celebrating Vietnamese heritage through bamboo-inspired structures, folk shows, and traditional games. Surrounded by gardens and peaceful landscapes, it's an ideal place to explore local culture in an immersive setting.

Local Dishes

in Phu Quoc

5 local dishes you should definitely try while in Phu Quoc



1. Herring Salad

Herring salad is a simple yet flavorful dish, made from thin slices of fresh fish, mixed with onions, grated coconut, and herbs.

Locals often enjoy it by wrapping everything in rice paper with raw vegetables, then dipping it in a rich Phu Quoc fish sauce. It's light, fresh, and best shared over a slow, relaxed meal.



2. Ken Noodles

This noodle soup is quite special. It's not something you'll find easily outside of Phu Quoc.

Made from coconut milk and fish like barracuda or silverfish, it's a bit spicy, a bit sweet, and very fragrant.

It may look simple, but every spoonful carries the taste of the sea and the warmth of local kitchens.

3. Steamed Ham Ninh Crab

Crabs from Ham Ninh Village are famous for their firm, sweet meat.

The best way to enjoy them is simply steamed, then dipped in salt, pepper, and lime.

It's a simple dish, but when the crab is fresh, that's all it really needs.

4. Grilled Sea Urchin

Locals often call sea urchin the "ginseng of the sea," not just for its taste but also for its health benefits.

It's usually grilled over charcoal with scallions and peanuts, sometimes with a bit of quail egg.

Eat it right out of the shell with a squeeze of lime. It's creamy, rich, and unforgettable.

5. Phu Quoc Fish Sauce

Not exactly a dish, but no food list here is complete without it.

Phu Quoc's fish sauce is rich and full-bodied. It's made the traditional way, slowly fermented in large wooden barrels.

Try it as a dipping sauce or buy a bottle to take home. It's truly a taste of the island.

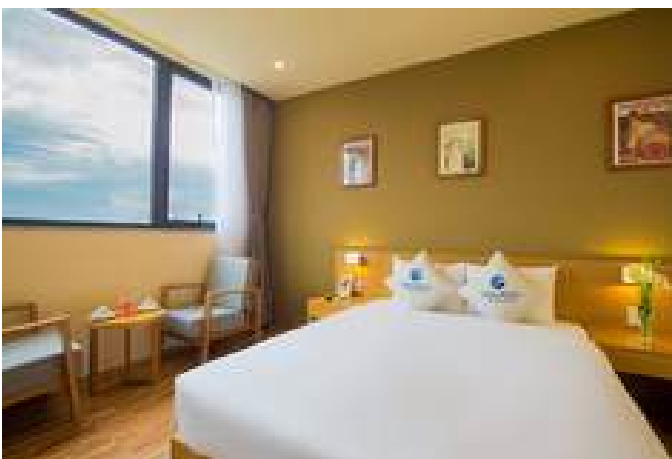
